ADVANCED TOOTH
WHITENING SYSTEM

Pola Night is a 10% carbamide peroxide, high viscosity, neutral pH tooth whitening gel. It is a pleasantly flavoured, crystal clear sustained release gel with a water content high enough to reduce sensitivity.

Indications or use:

- Whitening of discoloured vital teeth.
- Whitening of discoloured non-vital teeth.

Composition:

10% wt Carbamide peroxide < 40% wt Additives 30% wt Glycerol 20% wt Water 0.1% wt Flavour

Treatment Time:

For best results, 2 hours up to overnight

Instructions:

1. Brush Teeth.
2. Dry teeth.
3. Place a small drop of gel into every compartment of your aligner or retainer for the teeth undergoing treatment.
4. Ensure gel is at room temperature (not refrigerated).
5. Seat the tray, with the gel around the teeth.
6. Wipe away excess gel in mouth with a tissue or dry soft brush.
7. After treatment, remove tray. Rinse tray and mouth with lukewarm water.
8. Note: Treatment time can be overnight.
9. Brush teeth.
10. After treatment, clean aligner or retainer under cold water using a toothbrush.





ORTHODONTICS

Storage and handling:

- Store in cool place (2°-25°C / 35°-77°F).
- Do not use after expiration date.

Precautions:

- Irritant – protect eyes when using. Avoid swallowing.
- To be used under the supervision of a dental professional.
- Do not eat, drink or smoke during treatment.
- Do not smoke immediately after treatment - wait for at least two hours.
- Food and drinks containing strong colours should be avoided or consumed in moderation during the entire treatment period.
- Keep out of reach of children and pets.
- Not to be used by pregnant or lactating women or children under 16 years old.
- Patients with a history of chemical allergies are advised to carry out allergy testing by an allergy specialist before using this product.
- Discontinue use if any unusual sensitivity or reactions occur and consult your dentist.
- Do not inject Pola Night into the body.
- Please note, composite resin restorations, veneers, crowns will not whiten and may need to be replaced at your own cost.

First Aid:

For advice, contact the Poisons Information Centre (Australia 131 126) or a doctor. If swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting. If in eyes, hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water. Continue flushing until advised to stop by the Poisons Information Centre or a doctor, or for at least 15 minutes. If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Seek medical advice if symptoms persist.
